



TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Definition

The 'organiser' shall be deemed to be Belle Events Limited and its employees. The Exhibitor' will include any employees including all agents.

Application

All bookings accepted subject to the following terms and conditions and no addition to, or variation of, such terms and conditions shall be binding unless agreed by Belle Events Limited in writing. These Terms and Conditions will apply to all bookings.

Basis of the Supply of Event Management Services.

Belle Events Limited shall throughout the continuance of this Agreement provide an Event Management Service to the Client, taking reasonable care in fulfilling its obligations to the Client.

Price

All prices stated by Belle Events Limited, are exclusive of VAT which, where applicable, will be separately charged at the appropriate rate. Under no circumstance will package prices be negotiated unless agreed in writing by Belle Events Limited.

Payment

The Client shall pay to Belle Events Limited a deposit of 50% of the total price payable at the time of making a booking. The booking will only be confirmed by Belle Events Limited when the 50% deposit has been received. The balance of the total price payable shall be paid to Belle Events not later than 30 days prior to the event. All Bookings made within 30 days of the event must be paid in full at the time of the Confirmation. Should payment not be received as per these Terms and Conditions, Belle Events Limited reserves the right to sell this space to another supplier.

Variation & Amendments

If, due to circumstances beyond Belle Events Limited's control, it has to make any change in the arrangements relating to the booking it shall notify the Client forthwith, making the minimum of adjustments as possible. Belle Events Limited reserves the right to:

- a) amend any accidental error invoicing or confirmation;
- b) amend package prices.

Cancellations

If the Client wishes to cancel the booking he may do so at any time by written notice to Belle Events Limited. The client will receive a refund as follows:

- a) The full amount if cancelled 3 months before the event,
- b) 50% if cancelled 2 months before the event.
- c) No refund will be offered if cancelled 4 weeks before the event.

Belle Events Limited may cancel a booking at any time if:

- a) the Client is in breach of any of its obligations hereunder;
- b) the Client ceases or threatens to cease to carry on business;
- c) any circumstances whatsoever beyond the reasonable control of Belle Events Limited (including cancellation via the venue, through no fault of Belle Events Limited).

Liability

Where an Event is cancelled or terminated, Belle Events Limited shall not be liable to the Client or be deemed to be in breach of these terms and conditions by reason of any delay in performing, or any failure to perform, any of Belle Events Limited's obligations if the delay or failure was due to any cause beyond Belle Events Limited reasonable control. Belle Events Limited will not be liable for eventualities caused by the exhibitor which may cause injury, disfigurement or damage to any visitor. Belle Events Limited will not be liable for any damaged to the venue or the property of the venue caused by the exhibitor.

Exhibitors Liability For Loss Or Damage

It is the exhibitors sole responsibility to ensure that they have correct insurance to cover fittings, fixtures and equipment bought to the Wedding Show. Belle Events Limited will not be responsible for any loss or damage caused.

Insurance

It is the responsibility of exhibitors to provide their own Public Liability insurance.

Electricity

Exhibitors must advise Belle Events Limited if electricity is required, all electrical items must be PAT tested by the exhibitor.

Set up/Duration/Dismantling of Exhibition Stand/Space

Access to venue to erect stand or dress space will be notified 1 week prior to the event with all stands being operational 15 minutes before the start of the event. Stands must not be dismantled part way through the event for Health and Safety reasons and must remain until exhibition closing time.

Force Majeure

Neither Belle Events Limited nor the Client will be liable should the event need to be delayed. If the delay was deemed the result of...
– an act of God, fire or explosion, flooding, accident; war or threat of war, or industrial actions.

Severance

If any provision of these terms and conditions is held by any competent authority to be invalid or unenforceable in whole or in part the validity of the other provisions of these terms and conditions and the remainder of the provision in question shall not be affected thereby.

Copyright

Belle Events Limited reserves all copyright and any other rights (if any) which may subsist in the products of, or in connection with, the provision of Belle Events Limited's services or facilities. Belle Events Limited will take action if copyright is breached.

Amendment of Rules

Belle Events Limited reserves the right to alter, add to or amend any of these Terms and Conditions.
